

Cornhole



Game Set Up:

- Game is played on a flat surface.
- Boards are set up directly facing each other with 27 feet between the front edge of each board.
- Cornhole will be played with two (2) players from each club.
- Each team picks four (4) bags of the same color.

Game Play:

- Two teams, consisting of two players, compete against one another until a winning team is determined.
- The team to go first will be determined by the flip of a coin.
- A player from each team will play from the designated pitcher's box or behind the assigned foul line and throw their bags toward the facing Board.
- Players must pitch the bag with an under-hand release.
- Throwing alternates between the two opponents until all eight bags have been thrown.
- Player's feet may not go past the front edge of the board. If they do, a foul is called and the bag thrown is disqualified.
- If a tossed bag hits the ground and bounces up on the board, it must be removed from play before any other bags are thrown.
- If the bag is hanging off the board and touching the ground, remove that as well.
- When all eight bags have been tossed to the other side, add up the score (see scoring below). The team who earned the most points in that single round, will throw first in the next round which is played by the other two players on the team and is thrown from the end of the Boards just played.

Scoring and Winning:

- After all bags are thrown:
 - A bag remaining on the Board is worth 1 point.
 - A bag that went in the hole is worth 3 points.
 - Add up the total scored by each team.
 - Equal points cancel each other out so that only one team can score per round. For example: if one team scored five points and the other team scored three, the points added will be two points to the score for the team who scored five. If there is a tie in the total points, no points will be awarded and the team that threw first in the last round will throw first again in the next round.
 - A game is won when a team reaches 21 points with a lead of two or more points.
