DOMINOES GAME RULES

- Dominoes will be played single elimination; the winner of 2 out of 3 games moves on to the next level.
- Each player drawing for high domino will determine the first down.
- 3. The opposing team member to the right of the player with the down will shuffle the dominoes.
- 4. Any player may throw in the drawn dominoes if they have four or more doubles. This must be done before the first domino is played by the player with the down; all players must have time to look at their dominoes before the first domino is played. The down will then automatically be passed to the next player in the rotation.
- 5. The player with the down may start with any domino (not necessarily a double).
- 6. The first double domino played will be the only spinner.
- 7. The player scoring points must call the points; their partner cannot call the points. Points scored must be called before the next player lays down their domino.
- 8. If a game is blocked, all points remaining in the opposing team's hand will be awarded to the team that made the block.
- 9. The down will be rotated clockwise at the end of each hand regardless of who goes out.
- 10. The game will be played to 150 points. As soon as a team reaches 150 points, the game ends.
